1.) <u>Objective :</u>

Ragging is a Criminal offence and UGC has framed Regulations on curbing the menace of ragging in higher education institutions in order to prevent, prohibit and eliminate the scourge of ragging. The regulations are mandatory and strict compliance of the same is required instructions and notices to students and faculty have been issued from time to time and this needs to be issued again revising/updating the previous order :

2.) <u>Action-packed Anti-Ragging Committee :</u>

This constituted under the charge of **Chief Proctor** with **all HODs** (Except Mechanical Engineering and Chemistry) as Members and **Dr**. **Harish Nagar** as Member-Secretary.

3.) Anti-Ragging Squad :

This is constituted under the charge of **Dr. R.K. Garg**, **Dean** (**Basic Sciences**) and **HOD Mechanical Engineering** + **Chemistry** may be nominated as members.

4.) **Quick-Response Team** :

Mr. D.K. Sharma, Dy. Dean will head the committee with Mr. B.L. Pal, Dr. Gulzar Ahmed and Mr. Ankit Navlakha.

5.) **CCTV Cameras at Vital points** :

the utility and requirements of CCTV cameras has already been assessed and the work has already been done at vital points.

6.) Alarm Bells :

If situation arises, it will be decided by Dean and Dy. Dean. This will also be used in case of students unrest. It will be controlled by Exam Cell.

7.) **<u>Regular interaction and counseling :</u>**

This point has to be taken care by the faculties. During FDP a special stress has been given to this point. A combined team of Chief Proctor and Dean, Basic Sciences will keep a vigil and identify such persons and take necessary preventive action.

8.) **Prominence to Anti-Ragging in Prospectors and Brochure :**

The information to this effect is to be published at prominent places and surprise inspection of Hostels, Students Accommodations, Canteen, restcum recreational rooms, Toilets, bus-stands be also made by Chief Proctor and Dean, Basic Sciences at regular intervals so as to prevent/quell ragging and any uncalled for behavior/incident.

9.) Parent Teacher Association (PTAs) be formed :

Dean, Basic Sciences will prepare the modalities and make it an effective tool of maintaining discipline and environment for anti-ragging in the campus.
