



Mewar University and Indian Institute of Sugarcane Research (IISR) **Collaborative Programme**



IISR, Lucknow was established in 1952 by the erstwhile Indian Central Sugarcane Committee for conducting research on fundamental and applied aspects of sugarcane culture as well as to coordinate the research work done on this crop in different states of the country. The Government of India took over the Institute from the Indian Central Sugarcane Committee on 1st January, 1954. It was transferred to the Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR), New Delhi on April 1, 1969. The Institute is located in Lucknow, the capital city of Uttar Pradesh

The following training programmes have been introduced w.e.f. July 2013 session in collaboration with IISR. The students of Mewar University would avail the laboratory facilities of IISR whilst pursuing their studies.

1. **Integrated M.tech and PhD Prog.** in Agronomy, Biochemistry (plant Science), plant physiology, Biotechnology (plant science), Entomology, Agricultural Engg.(farm machinery and power), Soil and water conservation energy, Agricultural Economics.

Eligibility: Engg. In any discipline in Agronomy, Biochemistry (plant Science), plant physiology, Biotechnology (plant science), Entomology, Agricultural Engg.(farm machinery and power), Soil and water conservation energy, Agricultural Economics.

2. **PhD Programme**

Eligibility: PG in Agronomy, Biochemistry (plant Science), plant physiology, Biotechnology (plant science), Entomology, Agricultural Engg.(farm machinery and power), Soil and water conservation energy, Agricultural Economics.

Mewar University is conducting these programmes at University Campus. Students enrolled in these programmes will be sent for using practical Lab and research in above mentioned Institute.
