<u>Universite' de Nantes (France)</u>: Founded in the XVth century, then closed for nearly 200 years, Université de Nantes reopened in 1962 and went on to become one of the top French universities. Today, Université de Nantes is one of France's top multidisciplinary universities. The University has campuses in Nantes, Saint-Nazaire and La Roche-sur-Yon. Université de Nantes is a multidisciplinary university and offers programs in most fields of knowledge. Currently, the University is attended by approximately 34,500 students. More than 10% of them are international students coming from 110 countries.

The following programmes are started w.e.f July 2014 session in collaboration with Universite de Nantes (France):

- 1. Exchange of Students on a basis of reciprocity
- 2. Exchange of faculty for periods to be defined in order to conduct common researches.
- 3. Exchange of Academic Information and scientific research materials.
- 4. Conducting Collaborative research projects
- 5. Conducting lectures and organising symposia
- 6. Sharing of Expertise and initiatives in the interest of both institutions.
