



Memorandum of Understanding Concerning Academic and Research Collaboration

Between

National Institute of Technology Delhi

(Plot No. FA7, Zone, P1, GT Karnal Rd, Delhi, 110036, Through its Hon'ble Director)

AND

Mewar University Chittorgarh Rajasthan

(NH 48, Gangarar, Rajasthan 312901, Through its Vice Chancellor)

National Institute of Technology Delhi (hereinafter referred to as **NIT Delhi**) and **Mewar University Chittorgarh Rajasthan** (hereinafter referred to as **MU Chittorgarh**) recognize their strengths in research and academics in one or more disciplines of science, engineering, management and social sciences and their mutual interest in engaging themselves in academic and research cooperation.

Therefore, **NIT Delhi** and **MU Chittorgarh** agree to establish a programme for academic cooperation in areas of mutual interest, and in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in this memorandum (MOU).

Through this MOU, both Parties affirm the value of collaboration and agree to promote the following activities:

- a. Cooperate in the exchange of information relating to the activities in research fields of mutual interests;
- b. Promote appropriate joint research projects, and joint consultancy, with particular emphasis on national and internationally funded projects;

- c. Joint supervision of post-graduate and Ph.D. students;
- d. Sharing of infrastructure facilities (during free slots) for faculties and students of both Institutes;
- a) Promote expert lectures by faculty members for B.Tech/ M.Tech students of both Institutes;
- b) Conduct joint conferences/short-term courses/workshops/seminars on topics of mutual interest, as mutually agreed in writing between the parties prior to commencement of the activity;

The aim of the MOU shall be to enable realistic cooperation in the respective contributions and benefits of the collaboration, and there shall be periodic review by both Institutes.

This MOU places no financial obligations or supplementary funding commitments on either side. The above activities will be defined through separate program agreements that detail the commitment of resources (financial or otherwise) required by each Institution. Subsequent program agreements must be approved in writing by the authorized representatives of each Institution.

NIT Delhi and MU Chittorgarh agree to respect each other's right to intellectual property. Further, the intellectual property rights that arise as a result of any collaborative research or activity under this MOU will be worked out on a case-to-case basis and will be consistent with the laid down IPR policies of the two institutions.

The day-to-day implementation of this MOU will be coordinated by the **Dean, R&C, NIT Delhi and Dr. Jitendra Vaswani**. The coordinators, thus appointed, will periodically review and identify ways to strengthen cooperation between the two institutions.

This MOU will take effect from the date it is signed by the representatives of the two institutions. It will remain valid for **02** years from that date and may be continued thereafter also after suitable review and mutual agreement. Either institution may terminate the MOU by giving written notice to the other institution six months in advance. Once the MOU is terminated, neither **NIT Delhi** nor **MU Chittorgarh** will be responsible for any losses, financial or otherwise, which the other institution may suffer. However, **NIT Delhi and MU Chittorgarh** will ensure that all activities that are in progress are allowed to be completed successfully.







