

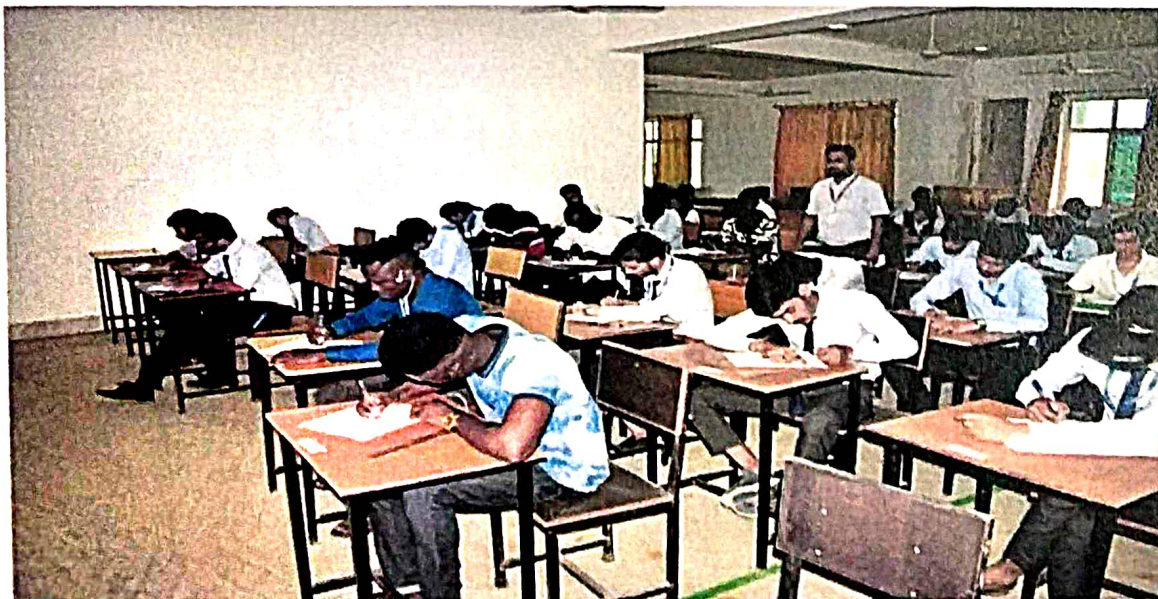

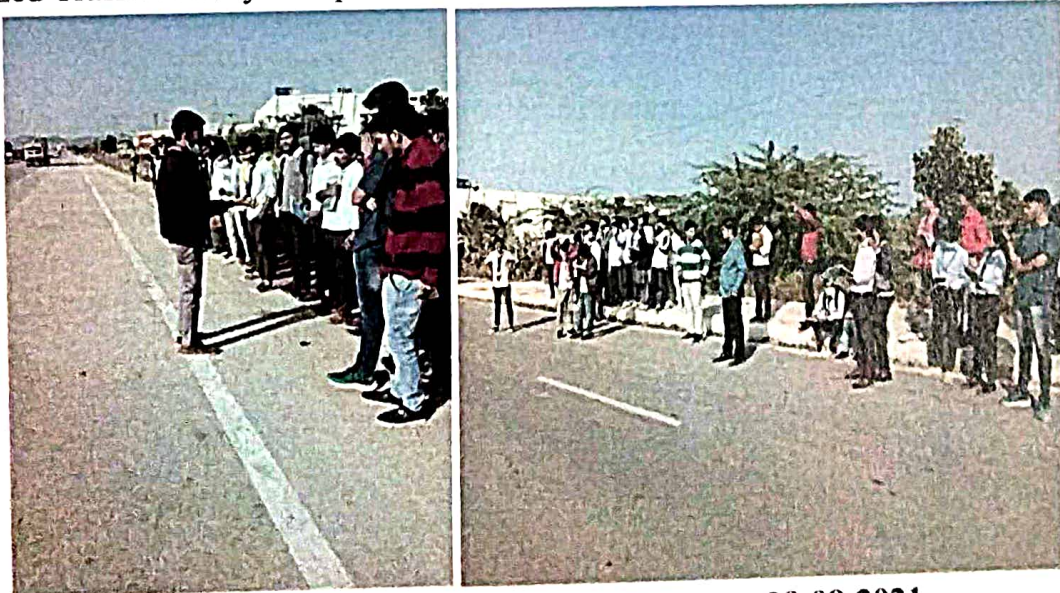

He explains the modification in behavior by raising awareness of gender equality concerns. He provides the information about the Vishakha guidelines by the Hon'ble Supreme Court.

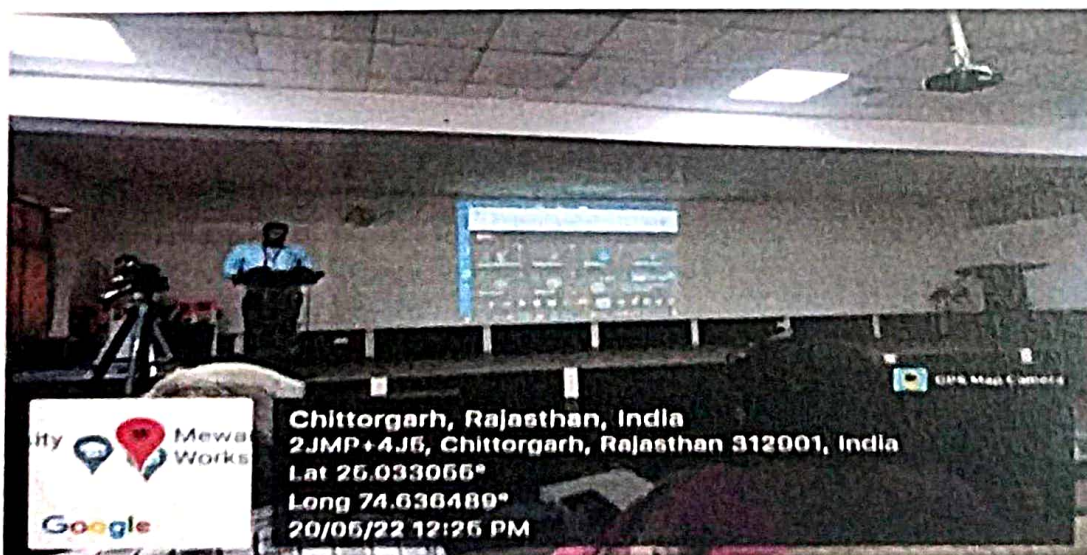

The Invited speaker **Dr. Sonia Singla**, Head Department of Economics, Mewar University, explain the topic of gender sensitization and the role of education in her lecture.

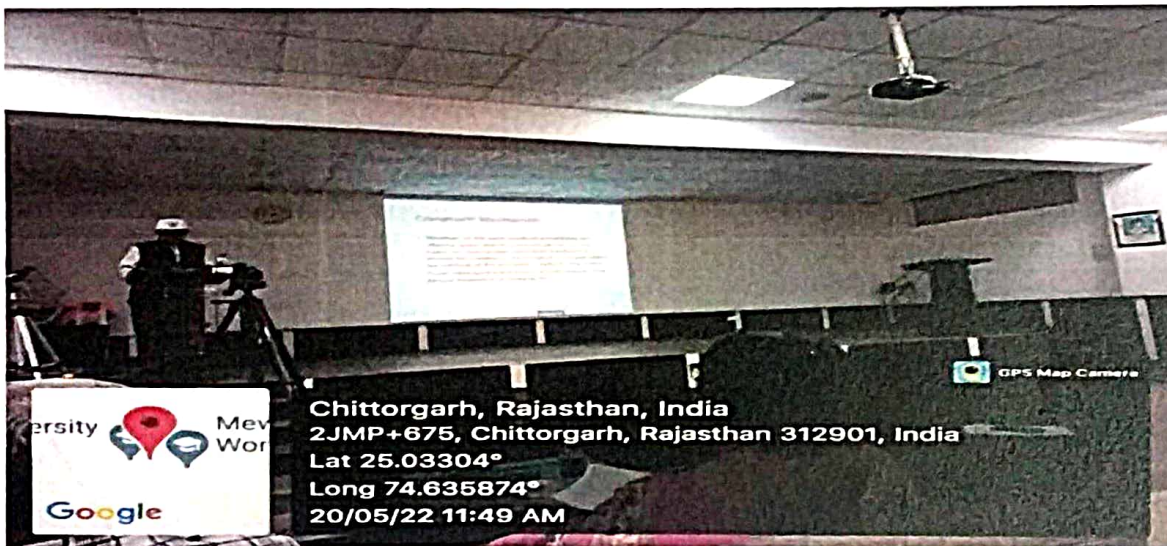


The welcome address was given by **Dr. Mohammad Ashid**. He enlightened me about the program and gave a brief overview of the topic, speaker, and the participants.

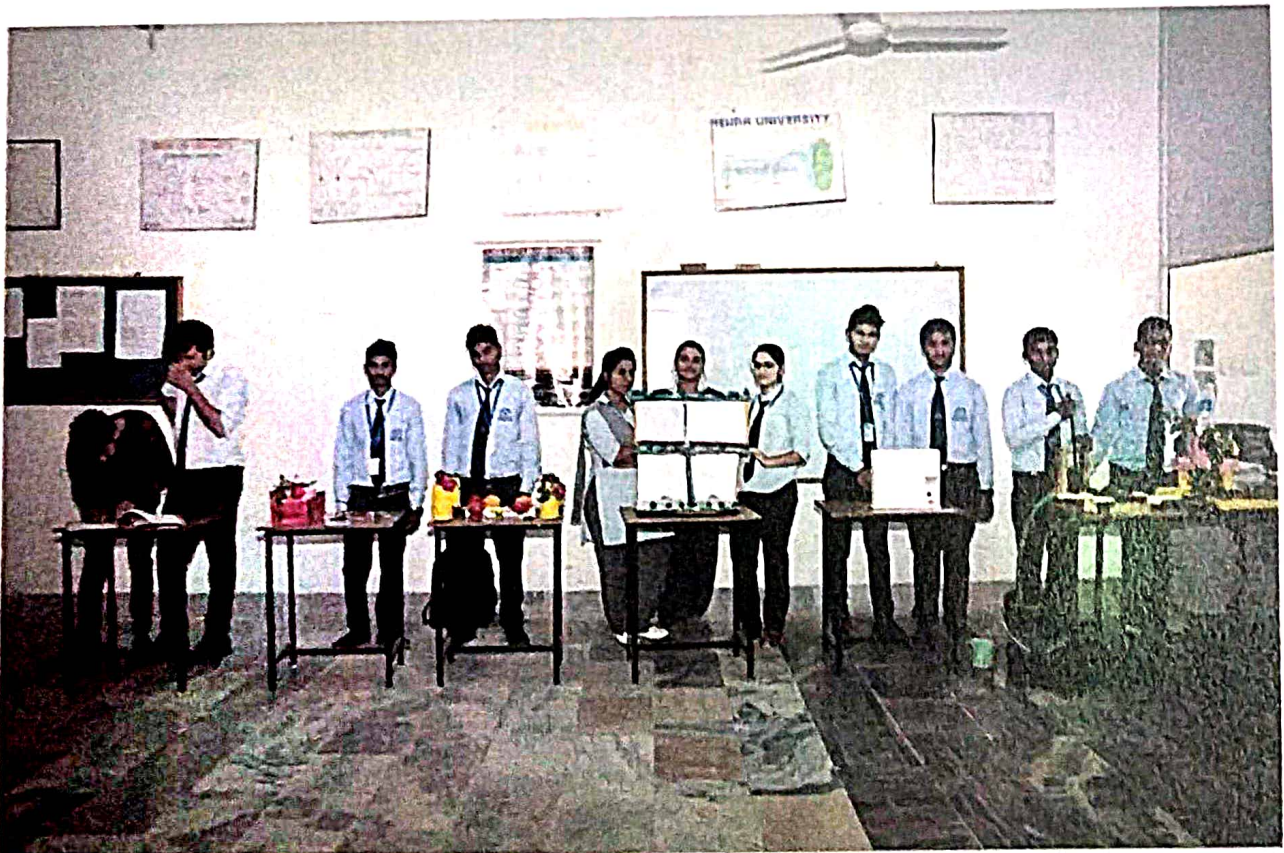
