The year under report was noticed with sigh of relief as the Hon'ble High Court of J&K accepted the writ petition of filed by the students of J&K and the University against the Ministry of HRD and AICTE against the non-release of scholarship to the students of J&K. Nearly 1300 students were given admissions to these students in various courses. They were not charged any tuition fees or hostel fees. They were given free books and uniforms. The AICTE refused to release the money on the ground that the students have been admitted in bulk and the University does not have the 12B or AICTE approval. This resulted in lot of money to be borrowed by the management from bank and from their own kitty.

The Hon'ble High Court was kind enough to realize the conditions imposed by the AICTE for sponsorship of students to private Universities were at later stage and without the jurisdiction of AICTE moreover the ceiling of students fixed by the MHRD under the scheme was not fulfilled therefore there was no question that University admitted students in large number. The Hon'ble high Court appreciated the efforts of the University and accepted the writ petition of the University with directions to the MHRD and AICTE for release of money as per scheme to the University.

Approvals of Regulatory bodies of AICTE in the case of B.Tech, Pharmacy Council for the courses of Diploma and B.Pharm and Bar Council in the case of law course, LLB and Integrated courses were obtained timely.

Academic activities coupled with extra-curricular activities were held with enthusiasm and all students participated in one or more activities. The Jyantis and anniversaries of our national heroes were celebrated with honor and remembering them for their sacrifice for the nation.






Faculty of legal studies of Mewar University has successfully organized following activities during session 2017-18:



Year 2018:


The Department celebrated Subhash Chandra Jayanti on 23rd Jan, 2018. All the students of the University participated in the event.

In this current session, our department library have included Books, Reference Books, Dictionary, Hand Books, Pharmacopoeia and Periodicals (Hard copies & online).





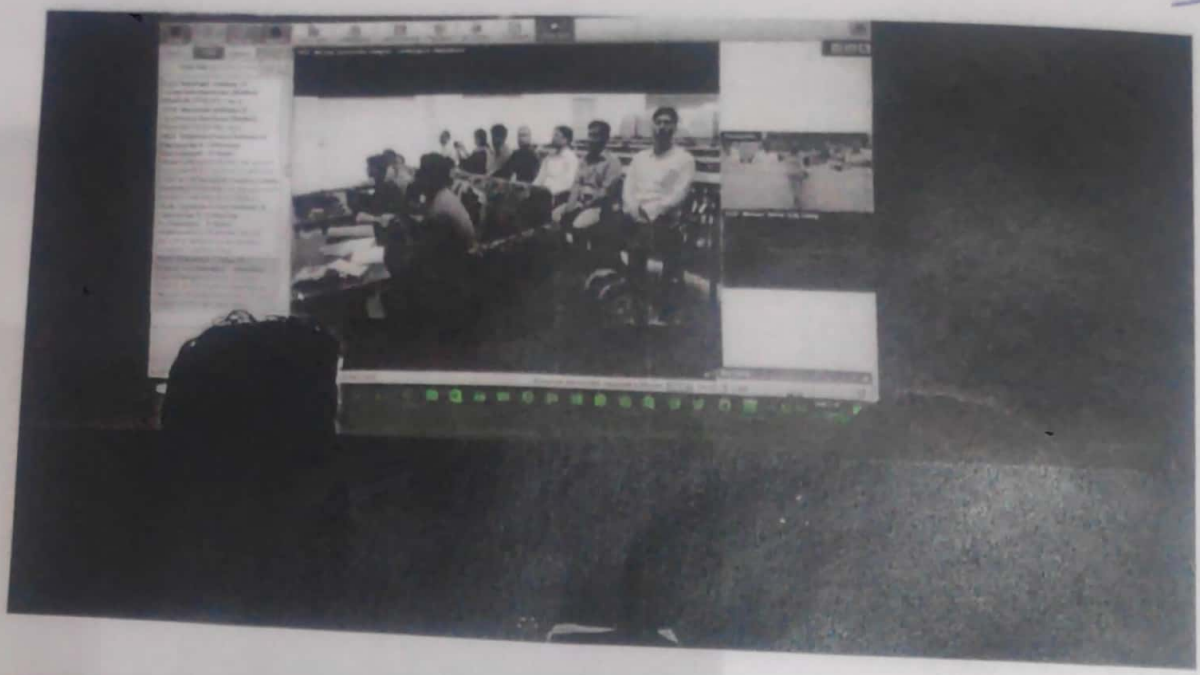
National Mission on Education through ICT (MHRD, Govt. of India)

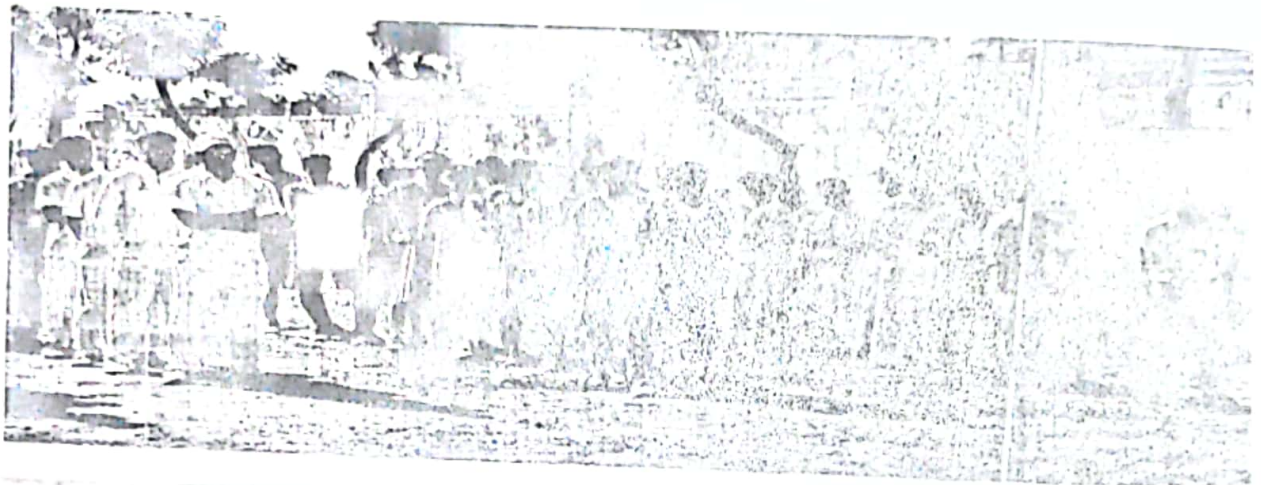
6th NAND LAL GADIYA MEMORIAL TOURNAMENT

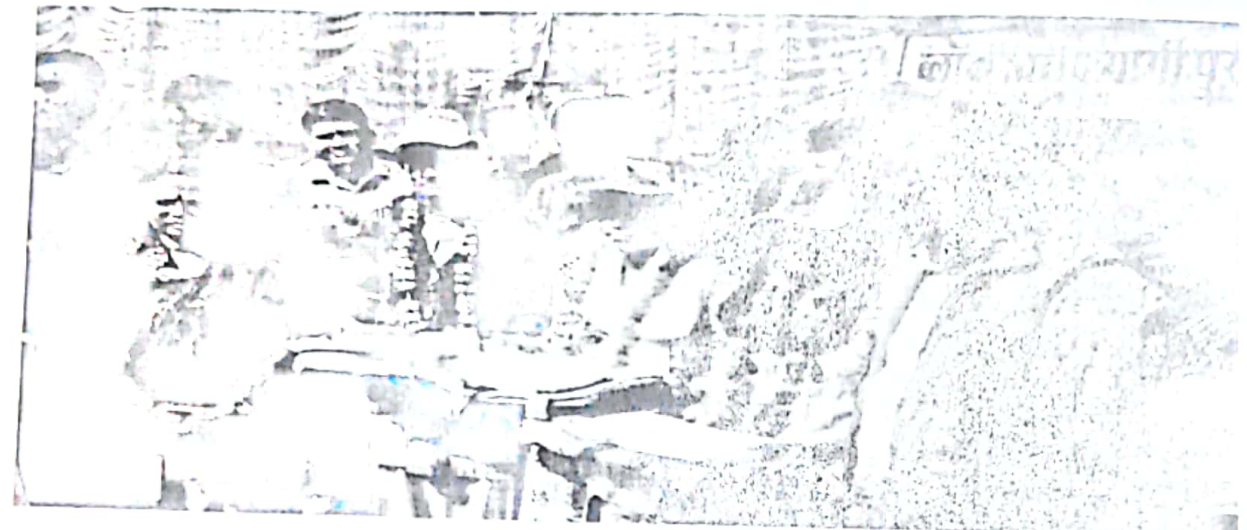

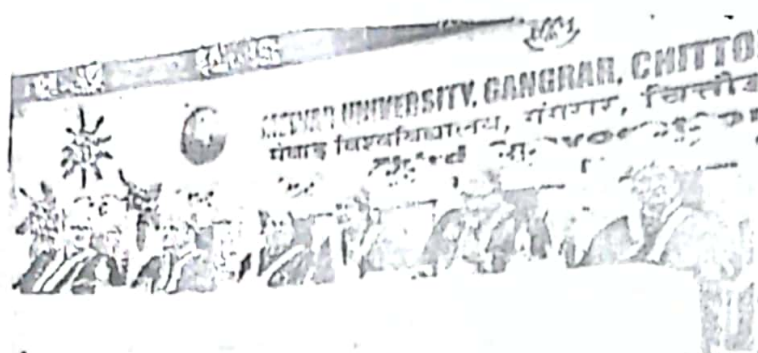
