This case is related to the central role of technology, especially the internet, in the success of new business. Some investors seemed eager to back almost any start-up with "do-com" in its name or its business plan. Although the go-go investment climate of the 2020's seems far away, entrepreneurs still start companies every year, and they are still making their case to the investment community. What business ideas do investors like? Is high still important? Public relations firm ABC corporations which specializes in start-up companies and those involved in technology innovation, conducted an online survey into the attitudes of 70 experts, including venture capitalists, entrepreneurs, journalists and company analysts? The central question was this:

- Do you believe that unique technology is crucial to the success of start-up companies today?

The remainder of the survey asked for reasons why technology is important to start-ups and invited comments form the respondents. In its news release, the ABC Corporation reported that 91% respondents consider technology to be important at least frequently. The breakdown was 39% frequently 39% percent usually and 13% always, the remaining 9% of respondents cited technology as important only occasionally, and none said it is rarely important.
